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






First Innovative Standards






Before there was a Hollywood...

On June 6, 1894 inventor Charles Francis Jenkins projected a filmed motion picture...moving pictures by way of reeled film and electric light... before an audience. It was "the first moving picture exhibition in the world".

This documented event occurred at 726 East Main Street in Richmond, Indiana.






